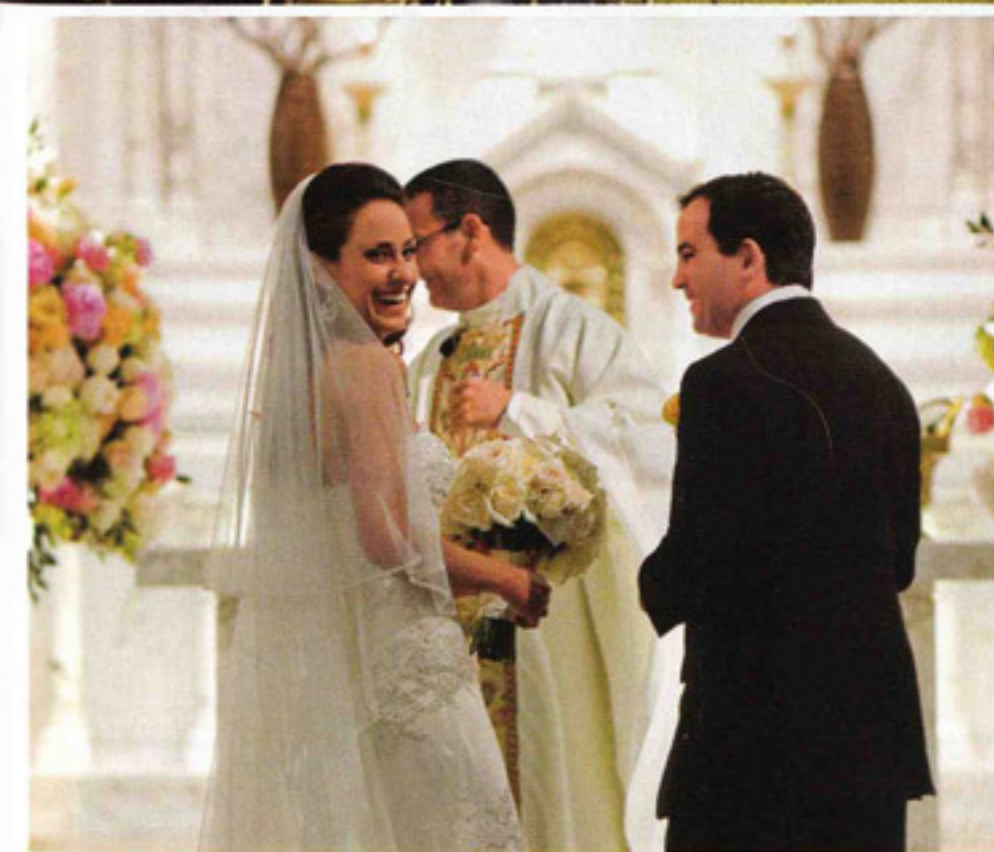
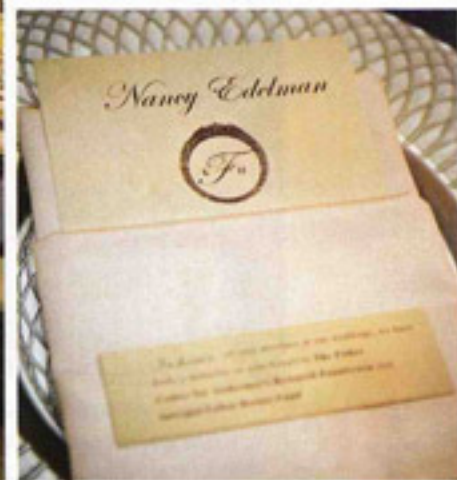


their story

the lounge

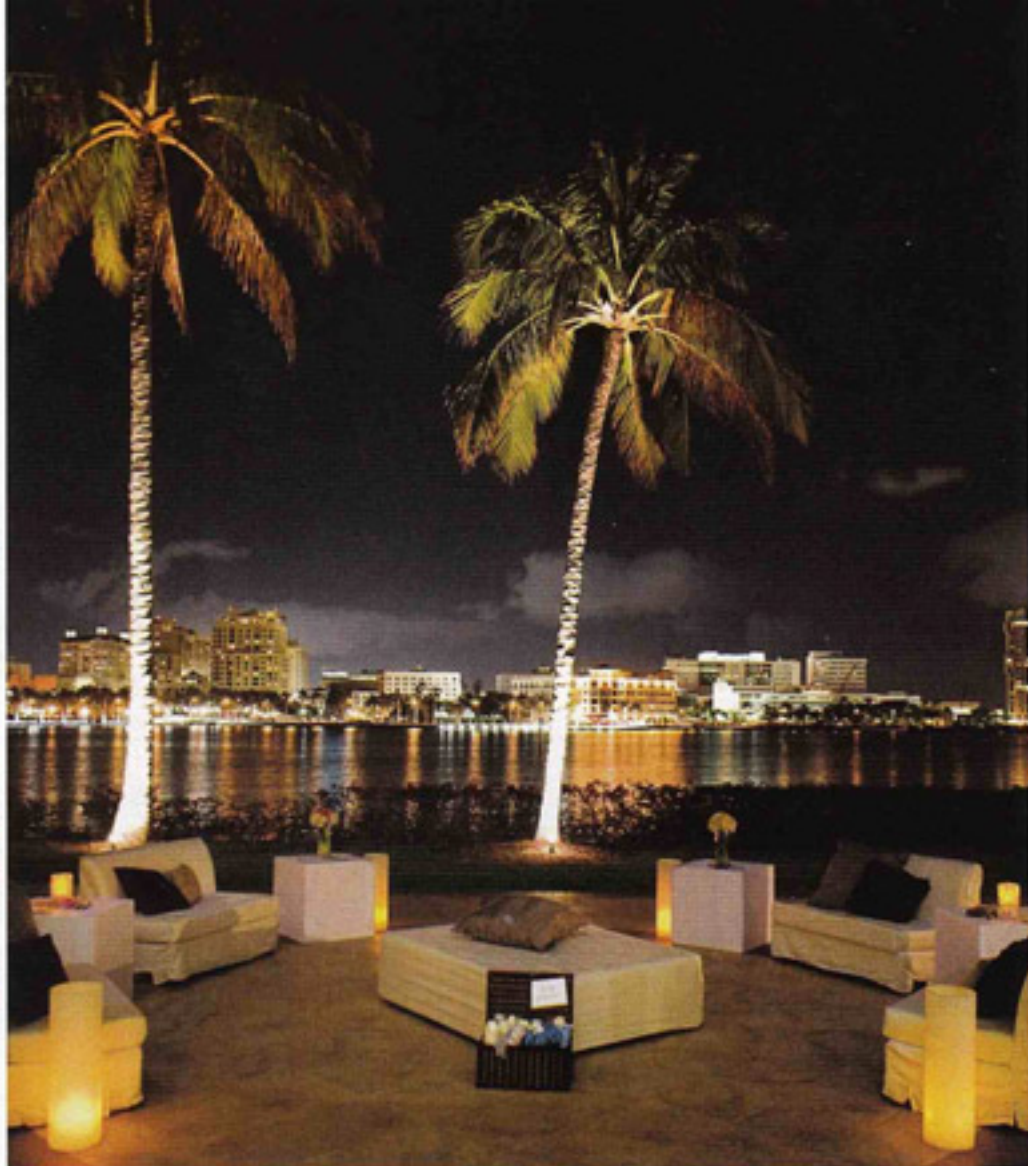

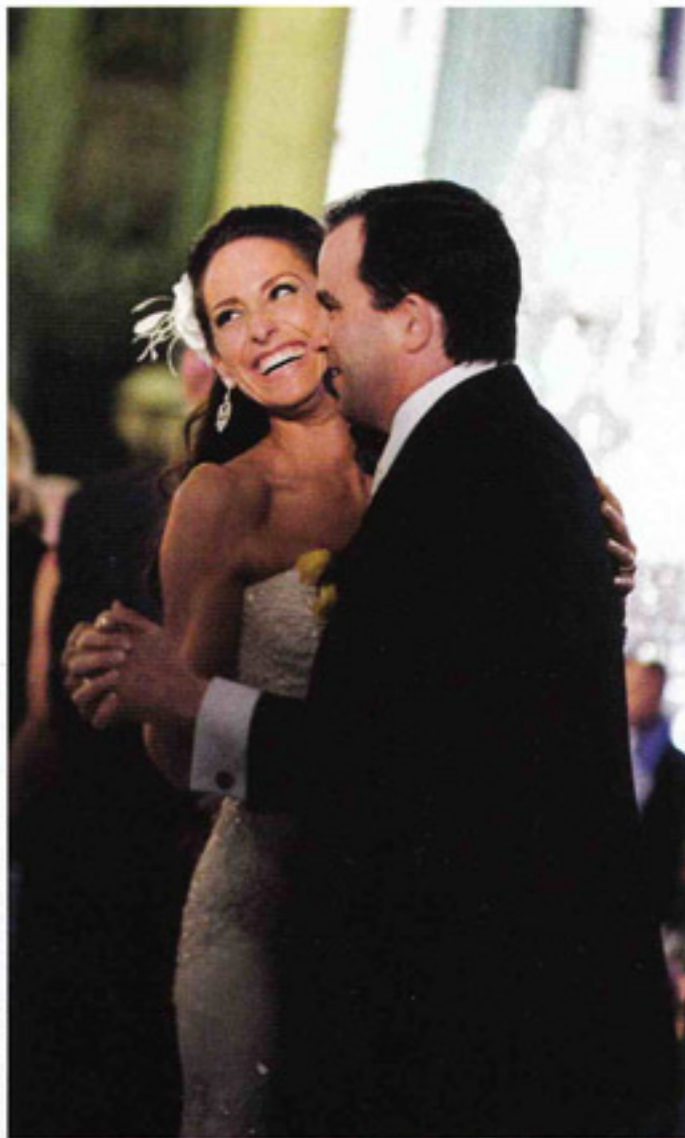
the cake
